Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject and your letter no. cited above, I am submitting herewith Good Practices displayed by Village Level Task Forces, NGOs and Civil Society in respect of Khawzawl District as under for favour of your information and necessary action:

1. Churches in the District are readily providing their Church Halls for Community Covid Care Centres (4Cs) to admit and treat asymptomatic and mildly symptomatic Covid-19 positive patients. This is esp
2. Village Level Task Forces (VLTFs), comprising mainly of village level authorities and NGOs, are providing food to Covid-19 patients admitted in 4Cs free-of-cost using money and materials donated by both individual and group benefactors. This shows solidarity of the society and also provides valuable relief for Covid-19 positive persons, especially for the financially disadvantaged who are affected the hardest by the pandemic.
3. In areas declared as Restricted/Containment Areas, NGOs in particular Young Mizo Association, under the supervision and leadership of VLTFs take orders for essential items from residents in the areas who are in quarantine, shop for them and then deliver the items at their doorsteps, with payments accepted only from those who can afford it. This minimizes movement of people in commercial and other public areas, thus significantly reducing the chances of spreading of Covid-19.

4. Vegetables and other edible items are given to villages in Restricted/Containment Areas by their neighbouring villages free of cost under supervision of concerned VLTFs, which is highly commendable.
